Dr Mohan Kaul is the co chairman of Commonwealth Inclusive Growth Services India Limited, member of the board and chair of Governance Committee of ICICI Bank UK and a member of the presidential advisory councils of Mozambique, Uganda and Zambia. He was also appointed Director General and CEO of the Commonwealth Business Council in 1997. His goal for the CBC is to achieve social and economic development through the promotion of good governance, sound market oriented economic policies and the enhancement of private sector contribution to the national economies. With his diligence and determination, the CBC today has become a centre of excellence well equipped to deliver cutting edge programmes for the Commonwealth's global agenda.

In his address to the batch-18 students of Xavier Institute of Management and Entrepreneurship , he gave his views on the importance of western business education. A PhD in Management Science from the University of Paris-Sorbonne, he was the past professor and dean at Indian Institute of Management , Ahmedabad. He emphasized on the need for various aspects of funded research in the Indian B-Schools.
