The **Anti-Drug Committee** is constituted to promote a **drug-free, healthy, and safe campus environment**. The committee works to prevent the use, possession, distribution, and abuse of narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances within the institution, in accordance with the **Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act, 1985** and relevant government guidelines.

Key Responsibilities

- Create awareness about the harmful effects of drug and substance abuse through seminars, workshops, campaigns, and counselling programmes.
- Promote a culture of healthy living and responsible behaviour among students.
- Monitor and address incidents related to drug use or possession on campus.
- Coordinate with the institution's administration, counsellors, and law enforcement agencies whenever necessary.
- Encourage students to report drug-related concerns confidentially and ensure appropriate action.
- Recommend preventive and corrective measures to maintain a safe, secure, and drug-free campus.

The committee aims to foster an environment where students can pursue their academic and personal development free from the risks associated with substance abuse.
