Dr. Bhatta, with his extensive industry experience and specialized training in Design Thinking from Steinbeis, Germany, joined forces with Dr. Joshin, Associate Professor with a rich background in engineering and consultancy, to deliver this immersive program.

The workshop commenced on February 29, 2024, with Dr. Ranjana Varghese welcoming the participants and Prof. A.S. Girish introducing the esteemed facilitators. Dr. Bhatta set the stage with an enlightening introduction to Design Thinking, outlining its co-creative process and the journey from understanding customer issues to delivering innovative solutions. Participants were divided into groups for hands-on exercises in Customer Empathy Mapping and Customer Journey Mapping, fostering a deeper understanding of customer mindsets.

The first day also included practical case study discussions and an engaging Aeroplane Game Exercise led by Dr. Joshin, demonstrating the nuances of product design and prototyping. The session concluded with insights into how Tatas engaged customers to enhance their products.

On the second day, the workshop delved into advanced concepts such as Synthesis, Ideation, and Scamper tools. Dr. Bhatta guided the participants through an Affinity Mapping exercise, encouraging collaborative chart presentations. Post-lunch, the focus shifted to the Value proposition Canvas, Prototyping, Experimentation, and a case study on Siemens, showcasing the practical application of the workshop's concepts.

The workshop ended with a service prototyping session in the computer lab, led by Dr. Joshin, and a feedback session where participants shared their experiences and received certificates of completion. The event witnessed 21 executives from various industries around Kochi, highlighting the universal relevance of Design Thinking across different sectors and roles.
