

TVS Industrial Visit by X-Ops

Date of Event: November 19th, 2022

Venue: TVS Manufacturing Plant Hosur.

The X-Ops, the operations club of XIME Bangalore, organized an industrial visit on November 19th,



2022 to TVS Motors Ltd. The aim of this event was to provide students with a hands-on learning experience by allowing them to observe the functioning of real workstations, plants, machines, and systems. Additionally, the visit was designed to provide students with the opportunity to interact with senior functional experts and supervisors from the company. A total of 69 student applications

were received, and 35 students were selected to participate, based on their responses to a Google form.

The visit was led by Dr. Christopher Rajkumar, and the students travelled to the company's Hosur, Tamil Nadu location via an institute bus. Upon arrival, the students were given a tour of Plant 1, which specializes in the manufacturing of Mopeds and Scooters. The plant is semi-automated, and students were able to observe the technical aspects of manufacturing, as well as the working of all the machines being used for production. The students visited the moped manufacturing division, and then continued to the engine assembly unit, chain conveyer assembling unit, and painting shops. The students were able to observe the real-



world manufacturing process and the use of different specific-purpose CNC machines and the material selection strategy. They also learn about Jishu Hozen philosophy, which is one of the pillars of Total Productive Maintenance (TPM) practices.

Overall, this industrial visit provided a valuable opportunity for

students to gain a deep understanding of the inner workings of a manufacturing plant and interact with industry experts. This experience will be an asset to students as they progress in their careers.

Royal Rumble by X-OPS

The X-OPS ROYAL RUMBLE is a project management competition that took place on 08/12/2022

at the XIME campus in Bangalore. 16 teams of 4 participants each competed in two rounds to test their skills

in project management. The event was designed to give participants a fun and interactive way to understand

and apply the Agile Project Management Methodology, which emphasizes flexibility and speed in project

management.

The first round, called "The XOX Game," required teams to complete a series of 9 tasks as quickly as

possible and mark a Tic-Tac-Toe board. To mark X or O on the board, they needed to complete a task from

the given list. This round tested the physical agility and strategic management skills of the participants. Only

the teams that completed the round in the minimum time advanced to the next round.

The second round, called "Mental Ability Test," required teams to solve a sheet of 10 basic mental

math questions and make a basket in the shortest time. The rules of the competition involved each participant

solving a question one after the other in their own decided sequence in order to move forward towards the

basket. This round tested the mental ability and time management skills of the participants. The team that

completed this round in the minimum time was declared the winner of the event.

The event was based on Agile Project Management Methodology in Operations which is a framework

that prioritizes flexibility, resilience and adapting to changes. The event helped participants understand the

importance of strategy and planning in operations, helping them understand how to utilize resources

effectively and how to prioritize their tasks and strategies in order to achieve the best outcomes.

The emphasis of Agile Project Management Methodology in this event was to strategize and make use of

available resources optimally in order to achieve the best outcomes. The competition was a very amusing way

to understand the agile methodology. Participants had to prioritize their strategies in order to win the game.

The event was interactive, engaging and a fun experience for participants.

The event was won by Royal Hunters (Ritija, Iona, Kushali, Karan) and the runner-up was Royal Rumble

winners (Subhalakshman, Havi, Kishen, Subin) both teams awarded with trophies.


