

6 th Nov, 2024	CPR Workshop	<p>On 6th October 2024, Xseed conducted a CPR workshop in the 1st-floor auditorium, led by Dr. Nitin PR and his team from Narayana Hrudayalaya Hospital. The session provided hands-on training in essential lifesaving skills for responding to cardiac arrest emergencies. Dr. Nitin highlighted that cardiac arrest can result from various causes, including road traffic accidents, and not only heart-related issues. His team guided participants through the "chain of survival" steps, emphasizing quick recognition of cardiac arrest, activating emergency medical services, and administering CPR.</p> <p>The workshop covered CPR techniques in depth, including checking for responsiveness and pulse, performing chest compressions, and providing rescue breaths. Dr. Nitin stressed the importance of rapid intervention, explaining that brain cells can be irreversibly damaged if blood flow stops for more than five minutes. His team provided practical demonstrations on positioning hands for effective chest compressions, maintaining adequate depth and rate, and using automated external defibrillators (AEDs) for certain arrhythmias. This session equipped attendees with critical skills for effective emergency response, highlighting the life-saving impact of timely CPR.</p> <p>This CPR workshop was invaluable for students, equipping them with skills that could make a life-saving difference in real-world situations. Understanding the steps involved in responding to cardiac arrest empowers students to act quickly and confidently in emergencies, whether at home, on campus, or in public settings. The knowledge of CPR and the use of AEDs not only increases their readiness to assist but also fosters a sense of responsibility and compassion, as they are now prepared to</p>

		<p>support others during critical moments. This experience contributes to their personal growth and helps cultivate a safer, more responsive community.</p>

21 st Nov, 2024	Blood Cancer and Stem Cell Awareness Donation Drive by DKMS-BMST Foundation	<p>The Blood Cancer and Stem Cell Awareness Donation Drive, organized by XSeed in collaboration with DKMS-BMST Foundation, addressed the critical need for stem cell donors to help patients battling blood cancers like leukemia and disorders such as thalassemia. These life-threatening conditions often require stem cell transplants when conventional treatments like chemotherapy fail. DKMS-BMST, a global non-profit, has already facilitated over 140 transplants in India and registered 1.4 lakh potential donors, working to give patients a second chance at life.</p> <p>The drive educated students about the importance of registering as stem cell donors through a simple cheek swab for HLA (Human Leukocyte Antigen) typing, which helps identify matches for transplants. The non-invasive donation process, involving the collection of stem cells from the bloodstream, was explained in detail, dispelling fears and misconceptions. Students learned that their registration could be a vital step in addressing the global shortage of compatible donors.</p> <p>This initiative instilled a sense of responsibility among participants, highlighting how their small act of registering could save lives. For donors, the opportunity to directly impact someone's survival is profound, while for others, the drive inspires greater awareness and action against the stigmas surrounding blood cancer. It empowered students to contribute to a compassionate, informed society where everyone can play a part in transforming lives.</p>
